A PRIVATE MOTOR VEHICLE & DERIVATIVES

A motor vehicle not otherwise specified in this Schedule, being a:

- PRIVATE MOTOR VEHICLE (a motor vehicle used for social, domestic or pleasure purposes), or a
- BUSINESS VEHICLE (a motor vehicle used for business or professional purposes), or a
- GOODS CARRYING VEHICLE (a motor vehicle constructed or adapted primarily for the carriage of goods and not exceeding 4.5 tonnes gross vehicle mass), or a
- MOTOR OMNIBUS (used exclusively for private purposes).

B GOODS CARRYING VEHICLE

A motor vehicle constructed or adapted primarily for the carriage of goods and exceeding 4.5 tonnes gross vehicle mass.

C COMMERCIAL PASSENGER VEHICLE

(within the meaning of the *Commercial Passenger (Road) Transport Act*) being a:

- C1 - Taxi or Substitute Taxi
- C2(i) - Courtesy Vehicle - where the vehicle has a seating capacity for more than 9 persons (including the driver)
- (ii) for not more than 9 persons (including the driver)
 - C3 - Private Hire Vehicle
- (i) Limousine
 - C4i - Motor Omnibus where the vehicle has a seating capacity for more than 30 persons (including the driver)
 - C4ii - Motor Omnibus where the vehicle has a seating capacity for not more than 30 persons (including the driver)
 - C5i - Tourist Vehicle where the vehicle has seating capacity of more than 30 persons (including the driver)
 - C5ii - Tourist Vehicle where the vehicle has seating capacity for not more than 30 persons (including the driver)
 - C5iii - Tourist Vehicle where the vehicle is a tourist motorcycle
 - C6i - Special Passenger Vehicle where the vehicle has a seating capacity - for more than 9 persons (including the driver)
 - C6ii - Special Passenger Vehicle where the vehicle has a seating capacity - for not more than 9 persons (including the driver)
 - C7 Special function vehicles

D MOTOR CYCLE*

A motor cycle used for any purpose, including being let for hire (otherwise than under a hire purchase agreement) but not being a motor cycle under item C5iii, where the capacity rating of its engine:

- D1 - exceeds 600 ml
- D2 - exceeds 260 ml but does not exceed 600 ml
- D3 - exceeds 125 ml but does not exceed 260 ml
- D4 - does not exceed 125 ml

E DRIVE YOURSELF MOTOR VEHICLE (HIRE)

A motor vehicle that is let for hire (otherwise than under a hire purchase agreement) without the services of a driver, where the vehicle is:

- E1 - a motor car
- E2 - a goods carrying vehicle (exceeding 4.5 tonnes gross mass)
- E3 - a goods carrying vehicle (not exceeding 4.5 tonnes gross mass)
- E4 - a passenger carrying vehicle for more than 9 persons (including the driver)
- E5 - a passenger carrying vehicle for not more than 9 persons (including the driver)

F TRAILERS

- F1 - exceeding 500 kg tare or 750 kg aggregate trailer mass
- F2 - not exceeding 500 kg tare or 750 kg aggregate trailer mass

G MISCELLANEOUS

- G1 - a motor breakdown vehicle used solely as a tow truck
- G2 - an undertaker's vehicle (a motor vehicle used solely as a hearse), a fire fighting vehicle (a motor vehicle used solely for fire fighting purposes) or an ambulance.
- G3 - an airport luggage transporter (a motor vehicle used solely to transport baggage at an airport), a ride on mower, a tractor, a garbage compactor, a forklift, a backhoe, a drilling rig, a sweeper, a roller, a loader, a scraper, a grader, a bobcat, a crane and any other vehicle not included in this Schedule that is not used for the carriage of goods or persons
- G4 - a veteran, vintage or classic motor vehicle used by a motor enthusiast
- G5 - a vehicle to which a pastoral permit relates
- G6 - a powered golf buggy
- G7 - a powered wheelchair, but only if capable at travelling at a speed greater than 10 kph

H TRADERS PLATE

- H1 - in respect of a motor vehicle other than a motor cycle*
- H2 - in respect of a motor cycle

J VISITING MOTOR VEHICLE

Pro rata the contribution payable in respect of the registration of an equivalent vehicle in the Territory; or in the case of a trailer.

K TEMPORARY LICENCE

A licence under section 137 of the Act.

L VEHICLES TO BE REGISTERED OR REREGISTERED UNDER THE INTERSTATE ROAD TRANSPORT ACT 1985 OF THE COMMONWEALTH

- L1 - goods carrying vehicle, a motor vehicle constructed or adapted primarily for the carriage of goods where the gross vehicle mass does not exceed 4.5 tonnes
- L2 - goods carrying vehicle, a motor vehicle constructed or adapted primarily for the carriage of goods - where the gross vehicle mass exceeds 4.5 tonnes
- L3 - motor omnibus
- L4a - tourist vehicle, a motor vehicle in respect of which payment is received for the conveyance of passengers, where the vehicle has a seating capacity for more than 9 persons (including the driver)
- L4b - tourist vehicle, a motor vehicle in respect of which payment is received for the conveyance of passengers, where the vehicle has a seating capacity for less than 9 persons (including the driver)seats less than 9 persons
- L4c - tourist vehicle, a vehicle in respect of which payment is received for the conveyance of passengers, where the vehicle is a trailer
- L5 – trailer exceeding 4.5 tonnes gross mass

* MOTOR CYCLE means a motor vehicle that has fewer than 4 wheels and is steered by means of a handlebar or tiller
